A strong team

In view last year on the Grand Prix of Plouay - Lorient Agglo - Trophy WNT Women, the Movistar team had not managed to win the biggest race in Brittany. For the 2019 edition, she comes with a very strong team including cyclists who already shone in Plouay.

The Bretonne Aude Biannic is of course every year one of the most encouraged by the public. The Brestoise, well known at the highest level in the world, is generally in view on the race Plouaysienne she has already had the opportunity to race eight times. Aude Biannic will not be the only woman expected on her **Movistar** team as Polish Malgorzata Jasinska and Spaniard Sheyla Gutierrez Ruiz, who have already made the Top 10 on the Breton classic, can also aim for victory.

This is only the second season of this Movistar team that did not take long to become a reference in the women's peloton. International, the team will present cyclists from four countries. The young Colombian Paula Andrea Patiño Bedoya will be the sixth cyclist of her country to come and ride in Plouay.

The **Movistar Team Women** presented its first riders list scheduled in Plouay under the direction of the sports director **Jorge Sanz**.

181. Aude Biannic (Fra, 28). With Audrey Cordon, she is the most famous Breton cyclist. Evolving at the highest level for ten years, the woman from Brest is a famous cyclist of the Women's WorldTour. She will live her ninth participation in the Grand Prix de Plouay. 14th in 2018, the attacker can finally succeed in hanging Plouay to his name.

182. Margarita Victoria Garcia Cañellas (Esp, 35). Author of a beautiful season 2019 with many places of honor at the highest level, she will race the Grand Prix of Plouay for the second time.

183. Alicia Gonzalez Blanco (Esp, 24). Regular at Plouay, the one who is also a brilliant cyclo-crosswoman will be a teammate for her leaders.

184. Sheyla Gutierrez Ruiz (Esp, 25). 6th in 2017, she will be expected again in Plouay on a circuit that suits her well.

185. Malgorzata Jasinska (Pol, 35). 7th in 2018, the Polish is also one of the women expected on the Plouay circuit. Malgorzata, Sheyla and Aude should form a terrible Movistar trio in the last climbs of the race.

186. Paula Andrea Patiño Bedoya (Col, 22). Promising cyclist from the World Cycling Center, the young Colombian will be there to gain experience alongside her leaders.

The announced substitutes are **Lorena Llamas Garcia (Esp)**, **Eider Merino Cortazar (Esp)** and **Alba Teruel Ribes (Esp)**.
